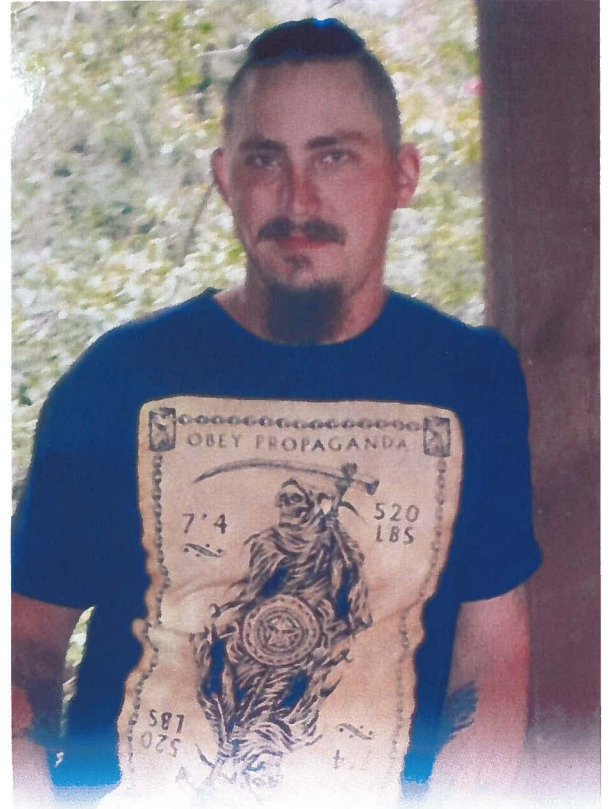
JJ's legacy of love, laughter and camaraderie will be deeply missed by all who had the privilege of knowing him.
